MAY ALTAR INITIATIVE: As you know, Pope Francis will be in Dublin in August to help us celebrate the World Meeting of Families. Pope Francis asks us to pray to Our Lady and to look to her and the Holy Family of Nazareth as a guide for our own family lives.

May is a special month in the Catholic Calendar when we honour Mary, and we do this in a special way by setting up a May Altar. We will have a May Altar in each of our Loughshore parish churches throughout the month of May and we would encourage you to set up a small May Altar also in your own home as a sign of your love for the Mother of Jesus and to encourage families to pray together as part of the routine of family life.

How to set up a May Altar: Identify a suitable location where the family typically gather, e.g. in the kitchen or the living room. Decorate the mantelpiece, window ledge or side table with an image or a statue of the blessed Virgin. Place flowers of the season around the image. A set of rosary beads, a small crucifix and a prayer book with prayers to Our Lady can also be included at the altar.

To celebrate the event, we would be very pleased if you could take a photo of your May Altar and we will display these in our churches during the month of May. You could also share your photos on social media (Twitter, Facebook, Whatsapp, etc.) to encourage others to pray to Mary for a renewal of The Faith our families.

MAY ALTAR AT BAWNMORE: For the past number of years in December a Christmas Crib has been erected at a public site in Bawnmore. Local families and parishioners have gathered to listen to the Christmas Story, sing carols and bless the Crib. Building on that emerging tradition, to honour Our Lady during the Month of May and to promote faith and prayer in our

families, there will be a public May Altar on that site throughout the month of May.

Parishioners from throughout the Loughshore Parishes are invited to gather there each Tuesday at 5pm for a public recitation of the Rosary. We will be asking the intercession of Mary, Our Blessed Mother, for the intentions of all our families. Bring your rosary beads. Donations of potted plants to honour Our Lady will be very welcome.

How to get there: From the Shore Road turn up Mill Road (between Dunelm Mill and Longwood Retail Park) and turn left into Bawnmore Park. The prayer site will be on your left. Parking is available in the surrounding streets and



also at Dunelm Mill and Longwood Retail Park. It's just a short walk from there.
