When you arrive at
Mass, Parish volunteers
will greet you at the
entrance to the church.
You will be given a small
counter for yourself and
for each person in your
family group.





You will then be asked to place the counters in baskets labelled according to age. There will be red counters for females and blue counters for males.

The baskets will be labelled with age bands.

The number of counters for each age band will be recorded after each Mass.
