
At 7.30pm on Monday 27th March at St. Anne's Cathedral there will be a 30th Anniversary Service for Divine Healing Ministries. The first interdenominational healings service led by Br David Jardine began in the Cathedral in 1993. During the worst years of The Troubles, the healing services were attended by Catholics and Protestants and included testimonies of healing and of reconciliation. Brother David has noted that: "During that time enormous healing has taken place in body, mind and spirit. Indeed, there have been quite a number of notable healing miracles, and we wanted to come together to thank God for everything He has been doing over these 30 years." There will be a time of worship, testimonies of healing and the speakers at this special service will include the well known priest Fr. Pat Collins CM from Dublin along with Br. David.
