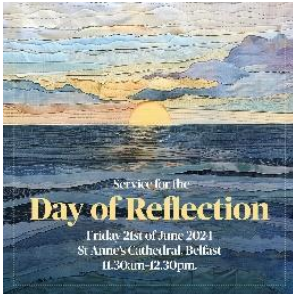

**DAY OF REFLECTION**  
Join us in a service which draws on the healing practice of lament, **Friday 21st of June 2024 at St Anne's Cathedral, Donegall Street, Belfast from 11.30am to 12.30pm.**

Using the biblical practice of **lament**, this service offers a space to reflect on the conflict in and about Northern Ireland as well as the future that is before us. In this space we acknowledge our deep hurt and pain, reflect on what we might have done or might still do, and commit ourselves to a future where such suffering and loss does not happen.

This is a service for everyone because violence has affected all of us.

Using the biblical practice of lament, Church leaders stand with victims and survivors in marking our collective hurt and in committing ourselves to ensuring we do not return to the violence of the past.

It is our belief that standing together on matters which are both painful and contentious shows collective civic courage. It is particularly important for Christian leaders to stand with and alongside the most vulnerable in our community. This service provides opportunity to do so within the context of ecumenical worship. We hope that you will be able to attend this Service for the Day of Reflection as we create spaces to share our communal loss without fear of judgement or reproach. This service is part of the Day of Reflection, established by Healing Through Remembering in 2007 and held on the longest day of the year in partnership with Corrymeela, Wave Trauma Centre, St John's Parish, Belfast Cathedral and the Commission for Victims and Survivors.
