SAUL SUNDAY: PILGRIMS OF HOPE 2025

Annual Diocesan Pilgrimage 1st June 2025 Slieve Patrick at 3pm. Celebrating the 1500th anniversary of St Patrick's arrival here in 432 AD, the Most Rev Dr Mageean, Bishop of Down & Connor, cut the first sod for the monumental statue on Slieve Patrick in Saul. The works took 6 years and the first Pilgrimage took place on Sunday 12th June 1938 when people travelled from all over Ireland to attend. So began the traditional annual pilgrimage, known as "Saul Sunday". This year, Bishop McGuckian will return to celebrate Mass at 3pm on 1st June. He encourages us all to be "Pilgrims of Hope", joining him at Saul to reflect on Patrick's legacy and welcome the "Sacred Heart Pilgrim Statue" blessed by Pope Francis to our diocese.
